**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

**Regular classes**

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.  
 8 inches - 11" & under at the withers  
 12 inches - 14" & under at the withers  
 16 inches - 18" & under at the withers  
 20 inches - 22" & under at the withers  
 24 inches - Over 22" at the withers  
 26 inches - May be entered at owner's discretion

**Preferred Classes**

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height  
 4 inches - 11" & under at the withers  
 8 inches - 14" & under at the withers  
 12 inches - 18" & under at the withers  
 16 inches - 22" & under at the withers  
 20 inches - Over 22" at the withers

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$15.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

**PRIZE AND AWARDS:** One prize given for each dog entered in the trial. Ribbons will be awarded to the first through fourth place teams in each class and height division (1st Prize: Blue; 2nd Place: Red; 3rd Place: Yellow; 4th Place: White). Qualifying (Dark green) ribbons will be awarded to those teams receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles. MACH/PACH/PAX Bar and Rosette will be awarded to qualifying teams. Prizes/trophies not listed in this section to be awarded at the Trial Committee's discretion. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

**RINGSIDE:** Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

**SAFETY/BEHAVIOR:** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.**

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog may be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.**

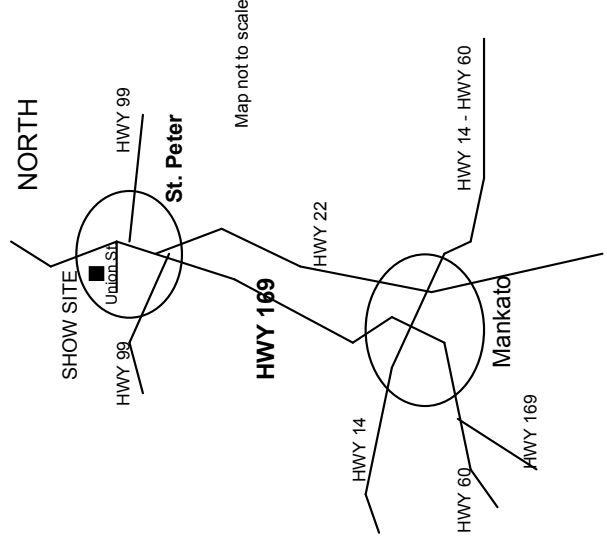

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
