# Key City Kennel Club Scentwork Trial

The KCKC Scent Work Trial will be held <u>July 30th, 31st, and August 1st - Friday, Saturday, Sunday this year</u>. More information will be available soon for dates and times of:

• Loading of the Trailer at the Training Center is tentatively set for Sunday, July 25th at 3PM

*Information for the following will be available from the Scentwork committee:*:

- Prep of fairgrounds area for trial in St. Peter
- Unload equipment at fairgrounds
- Trial start time and volunteer check-in time
- Cleanup of Fairgrounds and load the equipment back into the trailer.

#### JOBS AT THE SCENTWORK TRIAL

**Timer** – Will time competitors' runs ~ Good role for volunteers with: some experience and any mobility level.

**Gate Steward** – Will help manage the traffic flow for the trial, moving competitors up to the search areas, or holding back when needed ~ Good role for volunteers with: any experience and strong mobility.

**Judges Steward** - Will bring competitors to the line to start their search and remind them of the time limit and on or off leash options for the search. Good role for volunteers with: some experience and strong mobility.

**Parking Lot Steward** - Will manage having competitors on the line and ready for their turn. They will also help with making sure competitors park in the correct spots. Unlike Obedience and Agility trials where competitors can themselves see how things are progressing, this role will be key in keeping the trial moving. Good role for volunteers with: No experience and strong mobility

**Cold Box Steward** - Will set-up and adjust non odor containers (including buried hides) for the class. Good role for volunteers with: any experience and good mobility.

**Hot Box Steward** - Will set-up and adjust odor containers (including buried hides) for the class. Clean-up between buried hide competitors may be required, including sweeping, vacuuming, or returning spilled soil or sand to the container. Best if not entered in trial or after competing; will learn a lot about the sport working closely with the judges. Good role for volunteers with: any experience and good mobility.

**Score Runner** - Will carry batches of 6-8 score sheets from the elements to the scoring table throughout the trial. Good role for volunteers with: any experience and good mobility

# Key City Kennel Club Agility Trial

The KCKC Agility Trial will be held <u>September 3rd, 4th & 5th - Friday, Saturday, Sunday this year</u>. Join us as you are able, for fun with friends and to help our Trial run smoothly for everyone. Just like our May show, we will need plenty of volunteers.

• Loading of the Trailer at the Training Center will be on August 29th at 3PM for anyone who can make it - many hands make light work!

*Information to come for:* 

- Prep of fairgrounds area for trial in St. Peter
- Unload equipment at fairgrounds
- Trial start time and volunteer check-in time
- Cleanup of Fairgrounds and load the equipment back into the trailer.

#### JOBS AT THE AGILITY TRIAL

**Scribe** – Responsible for watching the judge for the simple hand signals used to represent course faults.

**Assistant Scribe** – Responsible for recording the run time from the timer and keeping the scribe's sheets in order for the scribe.

**Timer** – Responsible for starting the dogs when the judge is ready. Uses the electronic timers to time the run and quickly gives the run time to the assistant scribe.

**Gate Steward** – Responsible for making sure that the exhibitors & their dogs are ready at the starting line. Usually tries to keep 3 dogs ahead to move the trial along quickly. Informs the ring stewards when it is time to change the jump height (usually consists of yelling "last dog this height"), keeps the dogs in catalog order or notifies the assistant scribe of any change in order.

**Course Builder** – Responsible for moving equipment into & around the ring according to the judge's course plan. The course changes from Novice to Open to Excellent so equipment will need to be added and/or removed. After a course is set, the builders won't be needed until a new course change, so these people would be excellent as equipment setters also.

**Equipment Setter/Ring Steward** – Responsible for adjusting the equipment during the runs. These people will need to bring chairs to sit on the edge of the ring and are expected to be ready to adjust anything that needs adjusting.

**Runner** – There are 2 different runners needed: leash runners & scorecard runners. The leash runner brings the dog's leash from the starting gate to the finish gate. The scorecard runner takes the finished scorecards from the assistant scribe and brings them to the secretary.

### Things to Remember

• Our trial is held Outside, but now in a warmer part of the year, be ready for rain or heat and sun. The trial will be held rain or shine!

#### President:

Melissa recommended a disclaimer on website/application about adverse reactions. Have a waiver for conformation, rally, etc also.
- Also had discussion on rabies certificate storage/ collection.

#### Treasurer:

- Show report bottom line good, we made money (almost \$10K - \$9682.89)! Bruce still needs to submit some expenses. Also waiting on cheque from Onofrio.
- Rented golf carts one was dud. Thanks to Pete & Bobbie for bringing four-wheelers to use. Melissa L. made motion to reimburse P&B the same amount we spent on golfcart rentals (\$500), Brian seconded, carried (Bobbie abstained).
- Balance: \$ 15,701.34

#### Training Report

#### Delegate:

- Melissa L.'s name printed in May Gazette; vote will happen in July meeting, first meeting would be Sept.; has mentor arranged; will start preparing a report for newsletter once voted in; not yet hearing about anything that would affect us.
- AKC is banning dogs imported from China (and some other countries).

#### **New Business**

- Trailer repairs needed: Bruce needs \$\$ (~\$550 at an estimate) for trailer roof repair - waterproofing totally deteriorated, roof has sagged and rusting due to pooling water; Brian made motion to approve, Bobbie second, carried; Bruce will let us know if it goes over \$500
- Implementing raised prices on punch cards July 1st -(\$10/dog -) 12 for \$100 or 6 for \$50 (separate colors); all classes to use same card, add date; existing cards remain good.
